Beers sampled

Brewery	Name of beer	ABV %	Tasting notes
Green Jack	Golden Best	3.8	Good summer beer to start with. Refreshing with pleasant hop bitterness
Green Jack	Summer Dream	4.0	Elderflower Ale. Acceptable summer beer. Subtle elderflower flavours. Not very exciting.
Green Jack	Nightingale	4.0	Amber bitter. A pleasantly drinkable bitter. Not as distinctive as Trawler Boys (below)
Green Jack	Little Green Men 1 (LGM1)	4.2	Citrus golden ale. Those not so keen on citrus flavour preferred the Golden Best.
Green Jack	Gone Fishing	5.5	Fresh barrel. Excellent condition
Green Jack	Trawler Boys	4.6	Well balanced full bodied bitter.

The pub

Always has a good range of cask ales, usually six, sometimes nine, plus many ciders. By chance, and a pleasure to many in the group, on the day we visited all the beers were from the Green Jack brewery in Lowestoft. Beers are served directly from barrels in a room behind the bar. No jugs but we were happily served in half pint glasses, ordering by table, rather than collectively. Caravan site nearby means the pub is often busy in the summer.
