Brewery	Name of beer	ABV %	Tasting notes
Mauldons Suffolk	Pale Ale	3.6	Easy drinking. Citrus flavour not overpowering.
Lacons	Norfolk Gem	3.6	Described on the pump clip as "Best Bitter" but seemed more of an easy drinking session bitter. Promising dark colour but not a lot of body.
Wolf	Twenty 26	4.0	Seasonal ale brewed in winter. Rich brown in colour. More body than the above and more lasting hop flavours.
Nethergate	Melford Mild	3.7	A pleasant well balanced mild.
